WELCOME BACK EVERYONE

We are so looking forward to all students getting back to onsite learning at school as of Tuesday June 9th when our Grade 3, 4, 5 & 6 students return.

It will be wonderful to welcome all students to back to face to face teaching.

The transition back for the Prep, Grade 1 and 2 students has been particularly smooth and it's noticeable how refreshed and ready to learn our returning students have been over the past two weeks.

We will be here to support all students as they transition back to school. For some that will be full of excitement, while others may be apprehensive. Please let us know if you have any concerns about your child's return to school.

There are some changes of course to way we are operating due to recommendations from the Health Department and the Department of Education.

For parents:

Parents should only be in the school grounds if absolutely necessary.

Please remain in the car or beside your car at pick up at the end of the day rather than congregating at the school gates or in the school grounds.

We will not be implementing any changes to drop off and pick up times.

Ensure your child has a water bottle.

No child should attend school if unwell.

For students:

Extra hand washing and sanitizing is available in every classroom and also at outside locations.

Frequent handwashing and/or sanitizing will be enforced

Students will be asked to cough into their elbows or a tissue, used tissues straight into bin, avoid touching eyes, noses or mouths and not share food or drink.

No child will be drinking from the water fountains – every child must have a water bottle

There will be a cleaner on site each day ensuring additional cleaning and sanitizing across the school of toilets, playground equipment and high touch areas.

Students will eat inside at both snack and lunchtime. Handwashing and table wiping will be included in these routines.

Loaned Devices

All iPads, chargers and Wi-Fi dongles that have been loaned must be returned when the student begins school.

School Supplies Students will need to bring all their school supplies back to school when they return.

Lunch Orders There will be **NO** lunch orders for the rest of the term.

Staffing

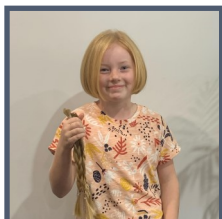
