We will once again be using the following platforms for learning while working remotely;

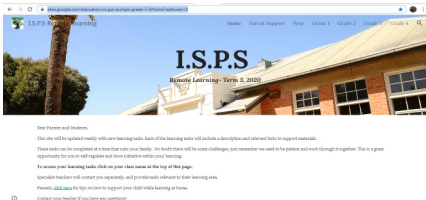


SEESAW

Teachers in Prep to Grade 4 use SeeSaw to post messages and notices. Students can access assigned learning tasks through SeeSaw. Completed tasks from SeeSaw or the website can be uploaded for teacher comment.
