Remote and Flexible Learning

Remote and flexible learning will begin on Monday May 31 and continue until Thursday June 3. At this stage, students will return to school on Friday June 4. Teachers are utilising today's pupil free day to prepare work for students and will advise you of the expectations via SeeSaw. Students took home learning packs, books and iPads yesterday, depending on their year level. We will provide some continuity of learning from home for the four days of remote learning. Official advice from the Department of Education:

Schools must continue to provide on-site supervision for students in the following categories:

- Children whose parents are considered essential workers as listed, cannot work from home and where no other supervision arrangements can be made
- Vulnerable children, including children in out-of-home care, children deemed by Child Protection and/or Family Services to be at risk of harm and children identified by the school as vulnerable (including via referral from a family violence agency, homelessness or youth justice service or mental health or other health service).

If your child needs to attend onsite you will need to complete the *On-Site Attendance Form* and return to the school office. This form was attached to the XUNO notification that was sent home yesterday.

Take care over the next seven days and hopefully we're back at school on Friday 4th June.

Camps Sports & Excursions Fund (CSEF) 2021

The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you have a valid means-tested concession card, such as a Veterans Affairs Gold Card, Centrelink Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible. Payment amounts this year are \$125 for eligible primary school students. Payments are made direct to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions and sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

If you applied for CSEF through our school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year, unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

If you would like to apply for the first time, please come in to the school office and ask for an application form. You can also download the form, and find out more about the program and eligibility, on the Department of Education and Training's Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund web page.

Check with the school office if you are unsure, and please return completed forms to the school office by the end of Term 2, Friday 25th June.

Parent Payment 2021
