IRYMPLE SOUTH PRIMARY SCHOOL

YEAR 5 SWIMMING AND WATER SAFETY PROGRAM

The Swimming in Schools initiative provides funding to contribute to the cost of delivering quality swimming and water safety education so all students have the opportunity to:

- learn how to swim
- develop lifelong skills in water safety to reduce their risk of drowning and injury

By the end of primary school, it is anticipated that students should be able to demonstrate the knowledge and skills identified in the Victorian Water Safety Certificate. The Certificate is awarded when a student can:

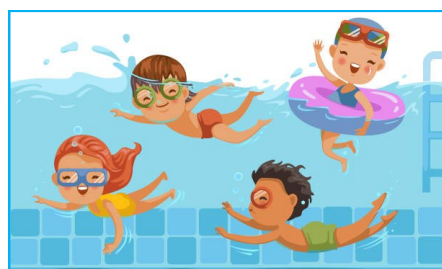
- swim 50m continuously
- answer water safety-based questions
- perform simple rescues.

In response to this program Irymple South Primary School are running an intensive week long program targeted at all Year 5 students, delivered by qualified swimming instructors at the Mildura Waves Aquatic Centre.

The program will run in Week 4 Term 3 from Monday 2nd August to Friday 6th August and will involve a 45 minute session each day.

There will be no cost to the students for this program.

Athletic Sports

Our Athletics Sports are fast approaching. This year we are running our school athletics sports day on the athletics track at the Aerodrome ovals. The athletics day will be held on **Monday 9th August**. Students will need to wear appropriate sports clothing and **HOUSE** colours for the day.

Parents will need to organise to drop their children off to the athletics track at the Aerodrome ovals and sign them in with their classroom teachers by 8.50am.

There will be no staff on site at school on this day. NO buses will be available to transport students from the school. **Students can then be collected and signed out at 3.15pm from the Aerodrome ovals.**

The day will start with the opening welcome and reading of the oaths at 9.00am. The students will then break into their year level groups and commence their events by 9.15am. Year level and monster relays will round up the day's events starting at 2.15pm followed by the closing assembly.

Due to COVID restrictions we will not be providing lunch orders on this day, therefore students will need to bring their own packed lunch.
